activities?**

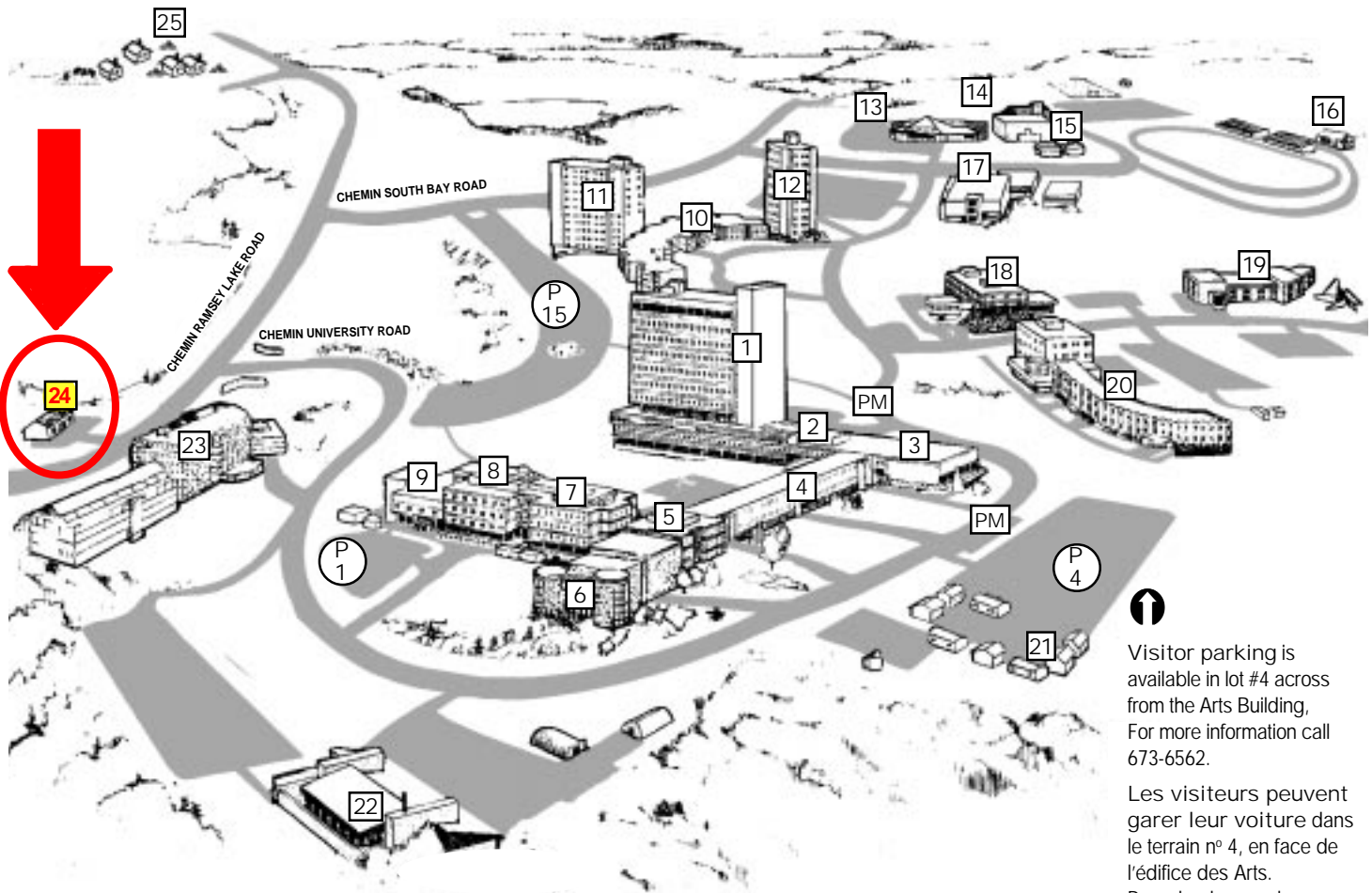

Chris Woodward is a Professor in the Department of Clinical Epidemiology and Biostatistics, a member of the Centre for Health Economics and Policy Analysis, Department of Psychiatry and Behavioural Neurosciences, and Program for Educational Development in the Faculty of Health Sciences at McMaster. Her published work includes book chapters, monographs and articles on medical education, health human resource planning, quality of care assessment, utilization of medical services, survey research methods, the epidemiology of child psychiatric disorders and of school-based injuries, and women in medicine. She has served as a consultant to the World Health Organization, several federal task forces, to the Ministries of Health, Education, and Community and Social Services provincially, and to medical organizations both provincially and nationally. Current research interests include home and community care, analysis of physician behaviour; the impact of women on medicine; quality of care assessment, including the use of standardized patients and the evaluation of health care programs.
