Demystifying AD/HD

This presentation will provide medical practitioners with the latest research on impaired cognitive mechanisms contributing to ADHD as well as the behavioural symptoms and comorbidities associated with ADHD. Psychometric tests will be discussed as well to assist in the diagnosis of ADHD. These topics will be discussed through an interactive presentation format.


Mr Robert Silvestri is currently employed with the Northern Ontario Assessment and Resource Centre as a researcher. Robert has obtained his Master's in Education from the University of Toronto and is presently completing his Ph.D in Education with a specialization in cognitive studies at Queen's University.

Robert's research interests include studying the impaired cognitive mechanisms associated with learning disabilities (i.e. dyslexia) and Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder. Additionally, Robert is interested in research examining the impact of disabilities on academic success at a postsecondary level of education.

Robert has completed research at the Queen's University Adult Dyslexic Research Centre and was awarded the 2004 and 2005 R. Samuel McLaughlin Fellowships and 2005, 2006, and 2007 Martin Schiralli Fellowships at Queen's University. Robert has recently co-authored an article entitled "Learning Strategies and Study Approaches of Postsecondary Students with Dyslexia" for the Journal of Learning Disabilities in 2008.
